Objectives and Investment Policy

Objective

Banor Capital Ltd manages the investments of this Fund. This Fund does not qualify as a "money market fund" under Regulation (EU) 2017/1131.

We aim to provide you with returns exceeding those of interest rates on deposits having a maturity of 1 year or less ("money markets").

Investment Policy

We mainly invest in deposits with European (EU) credit institutions that are repayable on demand. We invest in deposits with credit institutions that may be riskier than those qualifying as "high quality eligible assets" under the aforementioned Regulation.

We may also invest in bonds (loans) issued by companies or public issuers, which are repayable in less than 18 months, and in units of investment funds. We may invest in complex financial instruments which may have a significant influence on the return of the Fund.

Our investment decisions are based on a thorough analysis of the creditworthiness of credit institutions over the contemplated deposit period. We also take into account the level of interest paid on deposits with these credit institutions.

The reference index mentioned under "Performance Fee" in the below section "Charges" is only used for the calculation of the performance fee. A performance fee may be charged to the Fund in case the Fund has over-performed the reference index and has a negative return. A performance fee may be charged to the Fund even if your investment realizes a loss.

Essential features of the fund:

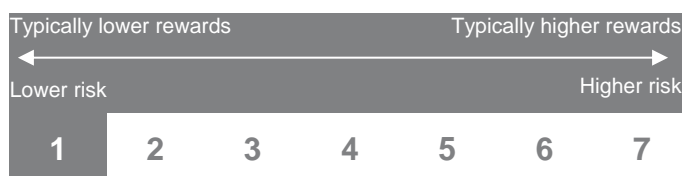
You can buy and sell shares of this class every bank business day in Luxembourg, if you qualify as an institutional investor.

This share class distributes a dividend.

Your first investment must amount to more than 100,000.00 euros.

In accordance with article 6 of EU regulation 2019/2088, the Sub-Fund does not promote environmental or social characteristics nor has as objective sustainable investment, as further disclosed in the Prospectus.

Risk and reward profile

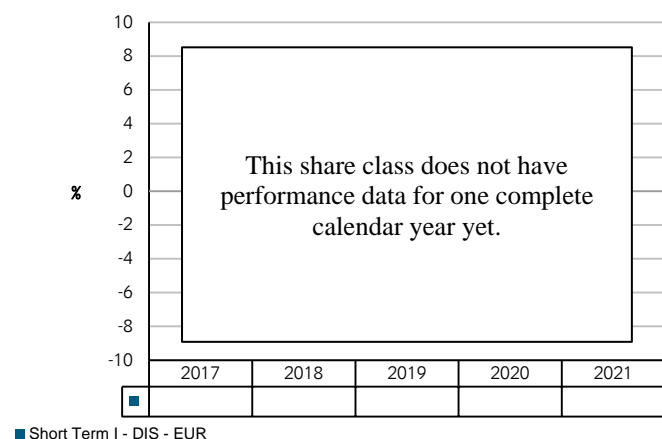
The entry and exit charges shown are maximum figures. In some cases you may pay less - you can find this out from your personal investment adviser or distributor.
